I was working at the Warren County Sheriff's Office when Inmate McIntosh shot and killed Patrolman Phegley during a "routine" traffic stop. I was working and present when McIntosh was arrested and transported to the Warren County Jail. I was assigned to guard McIntosh during his trial.

At no time during the trial did McIntosh take responsibility for his actions. In fact, he argued self-defense. Several days prior to the murder McIntosh was at a party and was showing off a sawed-off shotgun he carried in his car. When asked if he was afraid of being arrested for having the gun McIntosh replied, **"The next cop who stops me will earn that ticket!"** To our knowledge, Patrolman Phegley was the unfortunate next officer to stop McIntosh after he made his boastful prediction.

Anthony Wayne McIntosh has proven himself to be a cancer on society and I beg you **NOT TO GRANT THIS MURDERER** parole.
